
and rejoice, For the LORD has done marvelous things! Joel 2.21 (NKJV)

- DAY 27 We pray that your light pierces through every corner of this beloved country. The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone. Isaiah 9.2 (ESV)
- DAY 28 We pray that the joy of the Lord fills the hearts of our people. *Therefore in their land they shall possess a double portion; they shall have everlasting joy. Isaiah 61.7b (ESV)*
- DAY 29 Lord, let our hearts delight in you as you delight over us. I will rejoice in doing them good, and I will plant them in this land in faithfulness, with all my heart and all my soul. Jeremiah 32.41 (ESV)
- DAY 30 Let all nations know that you are the God of this land. Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD, the people whom he has chosen as his heritage! Psalm 33.12 (ESV)
- DAY 31 Lord, prepare your children of this land to be the salt and light to the world. But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. 1 Peter 2.9 (NIV)

"That my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth." ISAIAH 49.6 (NIV)





- DAY 1 With grateful hearts, let's praise our God who keeps our land. *He shall have dominion also from sea to sea*. *Psalm 72.8a* (*NKJV*)
- DAY 2 Together, let's turn our hearts to the Father to heal our land. If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7.14 (ESV)
- DAY 3 We ask you Lord for mercy on our nation. The LORD was deeply concerned about his land and had pity on his people. Joel 2.18 (CEV)
- DAY 4 Lord, pour out your Spirit over our nation. I will send down showers in season; there will be showers of blessing. Ezekiel 34.26b (NIV)

- DAY 17 Let the fear of the Lord be our nation's treasure. In that day he will be your sure foundation, providing a rich store of salvation, wisdom, and knowledge. The fear of the LORD will be your treasure. Isaiah 33.6 (NLT)
- DAY 18 God, we praise you for doing great things for our land. *Fear not, O land; Be glad*
